Family Service Centers

Purpose: To create welcoming hubs where students and families access tutoring, mentoring, project space, and services.

Features:

- Open workspace with tables/chairs for collaborative or quiet study.
- Maker tools available (3D printers, laser engravers, etc.).
- Small rooms for counseling and meetings.
- Workshops for families on learning supports, technology, and college/career planning.

Community Programs FULLY FUNDED

Custom Class braids opportunities and funding from city departments (parks & recreation, libraries, arts councils), the local university (extension programs, service-learning studios, research labs, tutoring), and community organizations (Boys & Girls Clubs, chambers of commerce, museums, makerspaces, youth sports/arts). Together we co-design after-school programs, weekend workshops, summer intensives and more to serve you.

Community Internships FULLY FUNDED

Beginning in upper middle grades and scaling in high school, students can complete micro-internships and semester-length placements with local businesses, nonprofits, and agencies aligned to their plans. Experiences may be paid or unpaid per partner policy and local regulations; Custom Class supports logistics—orientation, scheduling, basic workplace readiness, and, where feasible, transportation—and ensures compliance with youth employment rules and insurance requirements. Many internships culminate in capstone projects or lead to industry credentials and references.

College Options FULLY FUNDED

Custom Class partners with colleges and universities to offer credit-bearing pathways that can carry a student from general education courses to an associate degree by high school graduation and even as far as earning a bachelor's degree by the time they are 18 years old with credits appearing on both high school and college transcripts.
